## “Recent Developments in Competition Law within and beyond the EU”

Competition law across borders shares common key features, as most countries follow a tripartite system. Nevertheless, differences in both substantive and procedural laws continue to exist. The 8<sup>th</sup> CLU dedicates itself to addressing the most current developments surrounding competition law, not only with regard to the European Union, but especially with a view to jurisdictions outside the European Union – and to the Turkish Republic, the Russian Federation and the United Kingdom in particular. What are the fundamental questions to be raised in the field of competition law resulting from the United Kingdom’s decision to withdraw from the European Union? And in what direction is the rapidly evolving competition law of the Russian Federation likely to develop? Will it be a gradual harmonization towards the European Union’s competition norms or will it be a complete diversion away from European best practices? With **Eddy de Smijter** (European Commission), **Phil Evans** (formerly at the Competition and Markets Authority, United Kingdom) and **Andrey Kashaev** (Federal Antimonopoly Service, Russia), three well-known international competition law experts will provide first-hand insight into their legal regimes and give their views about recent developments and challenges.
